Sadia Binta Zaman, Lecturer, Department of Sociology, East West University

Sadia Binta Zaman is a Lecturer in Sociology at East West University with prior teaching roles at Green University of Bangladesh from 2022 to 2024 and the University of South Asia in 2022.
